I'm writing in regards to your complaint against Mr. Boog.

The scope of this office is limited to prosecuting violations of the Colorado Rules of Professional Conduct through attorney disciplinary proceedings. To commence an action against Mr. Boog based on your complaint, we must be able to prove he violated one of those rules by clear and convincing evidence.

I reviewed your March 11, 2002 letter and all the attached documents. My review, however, found no basis for proving any rule violations by Mr. Boog in your case. Therefore, I have concluded that the information you supplied does not set forth facts which would warrant regulatory review or constitute grounds for attorney discipline. For these reasons, our office is closing this matter and will take no further action on your complaint.
