Dear Justices Bender & Coates:

On or about July 28th of this past year, I wrote letters to each of you complaining that five or more complaints that had been filed with the Attorney Regulation Counsel have been ignored. Both of you, who I am certain have very busy schedules, declined to acknowledge the memoranda.

I also directed this same concern to Steven Jacobson, Chairman of your Committee. Mr. Jacobson has also declined to acknowledge and address this particular complaint.

Because, it seems, we have gone to the highest levels in the chain of command and, yet, have been unsuccessful in drawing any concern to the fact that John Gleason and his staff fail to consistently follow agency procedural rules and refuse to uniformly apply the Rules in the State, I have resorted to the "court of public opinion."

I and other citizens of the state have sponsor a [site/page](http://www.knowYourCourts.com) of www.knowYourCourts.com, which is a first of its kind in terms of the document repository that thereon resides. This page exposes the Attorney Regulation Counsel for the public, so that citizens can view and deduce for themselves what the agency does or --should I say-- does not do. The site includes the aforementioned memoranda that have been written and disregarded.

In addition to this Web site, [one particular blawg](#), which has considerable readership (including among State employees, using government computers), has paid considerable attention to the lack of accountability with the attorney regulation system in Colorado.

A natural consequence of ignoring legitimate citizens complaints and facilitating a system of lawyers protecting lawyers (where no one seems to be protecting the public), is that greater attention will be called to the problem over time. Eventually, legislators and media both will begin to demand accountability.
