The purpose of this letter is to inform you about my office's decision on your September 11, 2007 request for investigation of Ms. Wilson.

As you know, I wrote to Ms. Wilson regarding your request. Ms. Wilson filed her response and sent a copy to you on October 3<sup>rd</sup>. You filed your reply on October 4<sup>th</sup>. In my opinion, Ms. Wilson adequately addressed your issues with her daughter's employment and explained how that employment does not demonstrate a violation of the Colorado Rules of Professional Conduct.

To confirm my assessment, I discussed your entire complaint with the head of my office, Regulation Counsel John Gleason. Mr. Gleason reviewed your initial complaint, Ms. Wilson's response, and your reply. He agrees with my conclusions. Accordingly, the Office of Attorney Regulation has determined that additional investigation is not warranted. We are closing this matter and will take no further action on your request.
