Dear Mr. Wharton:

I have recently been forwarded a copy of the no contact order in effect between Debbie Samora and Enoch (Levi) Samora. I am well acquainted with this family and have served as the Special Advocate for most of this year.

As you may already know, the Samora matter is a highly contentious one involving serious allegations by both sides of the family. Judge Plaut has issued his order and father now has supervised parenting time with his sons. Father was placed in a supervised setting because he has engaged in alienating behavior, thus making the parenting arrangement between mother and her sons difficult.

I am writing this letter simply to inform you of the difficulty of this case. I am in no way excusing mother's actions if she telephoned father inappropriately. I would suggest however that you take a broader look at this family matter as it does not simply involve the viewpoint of one side of the family.

I continue to work with the Samora family as the Special Advocate.



Enclosed is the following information on my estranged wife Debbie Sue Samora. This is the second time I Enoch L. Samora Jr. have provided you this information. The last time I provided you a copy of this information was in person during my last office visit with you. I noticed not one Police report on Debbie's criminal Domestic Violence charges were a part of your final report by which you are required by C.R.S. 14-10-116 by law to do so. Colorado Statute 14-10-124 (ix) section 18-6-401, C.R.S. states clearly and decisively what was required of you as appointed by the court. As soon as the Arvada police report on 7/21/03 is made available you will receive this as well. I will also be forwarding you the Police Report on Debbie Sue Samora involving a 12-year-old male minor and her inappropriate behavior having been given permission by the mother to do so. This will be provided in writing to you after the mother on numerous attempts to speak to you have failed all on your part. These are very disturbing events and your lack of acting responsibly is very concerning.
