This letter confirms receipt of your letter and book of attachments, dated March 3, 2004, as well as your earlier correspondence to me concerning your matter.

This office has the authority to review ethical conduct of state-level judges. However, it does not oversee magistrates. Those individuals are overseen by the Office of Attorney Regulation, located in Denver, telephone number: 303-893-8121.

As for your complaint about the judge, after reviewing your most recent letter and attachments as well as my earlier response to you, I'm sorry, but I really don't have any additional information to provide to you other than what was contained in my earlier letter to you. I hope that you are able to talk to an attorney about the status of your case in that the issues that you have raised are outside the original jurisdiction of this Commission. With the information that you have provided, this office does not have the authority to assist you. Again, it's jurisdiction is only about ethical conduct of a judge, not the rulings or decisions that are made by that judge. Your allegations focus on legal issues rather than on ethical issues.

Please be reminded that this matter is strictly confidential pursuant to Article VI, Section 23(3)(g), Colorado Constitution, and sections 24-72-401 and 402, Colorado Revised Statutes.
