<p><b>APPELLANT’S MOTION TO SUPPLEMENT THE RECORD</b></p>	

COMES NOW the appellant and respectfully requests to supplement the record. In support thereof, Appellant states as follows:

1. The current record on appeal now consists of the entire trial court record from August 01, 2003 through May 9<sup>th</sup> 2007.
2. Pursuant to this Court’s [Order, dated April 18<sup>th</sup>, 2007](#), Appellant’s [request to amend his Notice of Appeal](#) to include the issue of an award of attorneys fees and the trial judge’s authority to grant those fees was granted.
3. Since that time, the Chief Judge of the district has issued [an Order](#) concerning the limitations of the trial court’s jurisdiction. Shortly thereafter, just

last week, Appellant received by mail [another Order](#) from a magistrate judge, which Order addresses the trial judge's jurisdiction and, yet, conflicts with the Chief Judge's order. Both Orders are in response to special appearances (objections to exercise of jurisdiction) by Appellant; both orders concern the gravamen of this appeal, which is the extent of the jurisdiction of the trial judge and the trial court. Therefore, in the interest of judicial economy and to eliminate the practice of piecemeal appeals, both orders are necessary to this Court's determination of those same issues already on appeal.

4. Neither party would be prejudiced by the within request.

WHEREFORE, appellant respectfully requests that the Court authorize the supplement of the record to complete the record now on file with this Court with any and all documents now with the trial court (approximately May 1<sup>st</sup> through July 13<sup>th</sup> 2007).
