Regarding the contempt citations: my files reflect correspondence with you in March and April 2005 regarding (a) a new contempt citation re denial of telephone contact and (b) a citation that you had previously obtained regarding the tax exemption and the parenting class (one citation intended to cover both your motions), which had expired on Feb. 1 due to failure to have Christy served.

I filed a motion for contempt citation (a) and a motion to re-issue contempt citations (b), on April 4, 2005. **My records do not reflect any signed order or citation from the court.**

Nothing I said to the court clerk on Feb. 9, 2005 would have any bearing on the April 2005 motions. \

As for notations of calls to me on May 27, 2005 and July 5, 2005, I have no record. I can tell you, though, that on May 27, 2005 I was in Colorado Springs. I returned on Monday, May 30 (a holiday), and **absolutely** would have returned any calls on voice mail left for me during my absence. On July 5, 2005, I may have been out of phone contact because I had been moving from the Broomfield address to the Golden address, beginning on July 2 and continuing through the entire 4th of July weekend and July 5th. It was a move from hell, partly because of the timing, partly because of incompetent movers, partly because I had to do it piecemeal, which meant that on July 5 I was hiring a supplementary truck to move the entire contents of my kitchen. My billing records show, however, that I spent two hours that day writing a response to CtApp's order to show cause in your case, which was possible because I had spent July 4 setting up my telephone and computer in the new office (the one you saw in Golden). I don't think I had to change my phone number, moving within Jefferson County, but I may easily have missed a call. Again, I absolutely would have returned any calls from Jeffco Court.

So I haven't resolved this mystery, and I don't have our entire e-mail correspondence, as you apparently do.
