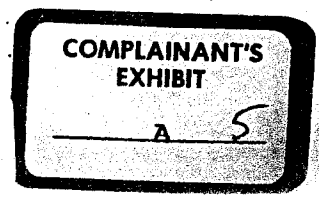

<p><b>AFFIDAVIT OF MICHEAL H. WILLIAMS</b></p>		

1. Since the summer of 1999, Michael H. Williams, Investigator for the Attorney Regulation Counsel, Colorado Supreme Court and former assistant regulation counsel Chrystyne Czarnowsky have been investigating numerous complaints involving respondent Shell. These complaints allege the unauthorized practice of law.
2. Upon information and belief, respondent Shell has engaged in the unauthorized practice of law by advising clients in court litigation matters, by preparing motions for submission to various courts of jurisdiction in Colorado for her respective clients.
3. Due to the complexity of this case, investigators have interviewed numerous witnesses, parties to the actions, judges, magistrates and other individuals.
4. In two letters dated August 22 and 28, 2000, former assistant regulation counsel Chrystyne Czarnowsky requested respondent Shell contact our office for a deposition in October 2000. Ms. Shell neglected to contact the Attorney Regulation Counsel.

On November 21, 2000, I telephoned respondent Shell to attempt an interview. Ms. Shell informed me she will not be cooperating with our office on any matter.

5. A deposition was scheduled for March 29, 2001, in the El Paso County District Court. Respondent Shell was unable to be served the subpoena for the deposition.

6. A subsequent deposition was scheduled for April 12, 2001, in the El Paso County District Court for respondent Shell. On April 1, 2001, respondent Shell was served the subpoena duces tecum by a private process server in El Paso County, CO.
