



<p>STATUS REPORT</p>	

Petitioner-Appellant, Bryan Spofford, representing himself in this matter provides the following Status Report as required by this Court's Order of March 30, 2006:

1. Judge Tidball held a 15-minute evidentiary hearing on the matter of attorney fees on September 29, 2006.
2. Gary L. Polidori representing Respondent-Appellee submitted a Supplemental Attorney Fee Affidavit requesting \$879.82 for fees associated with responding to Petitioner's Motion for Review Under C.R.M. Rule 7 of Magistrate's Order of

Attorney Fees pursuant to the Court Order of November 7, 2005. He also requested an additional \$700 for fees related to the evidentiary hearing itself giving a total of \$1,579.82.

3. The Court ordered Petitioner-Appellant to pay a total of \$1,929.82 directly to Respondent's attorney within 15 days, and he timely complied with the verbal order regarding payment.
4. Petitioner complained to the Court that he was not receiving notices or orders, and Judge Tidball stated, "I am not going to send out an Order in this case, that is just what I said. Maybe you did not understand that, but what we are going to do is put it on a minute order that will go in the file. I am not going to draft any more orders, I am not going to ask you to create an order or Mr. Polidori to create an order because I just don't think that it is necessary."
5. Petitioner drove to Jefferson County District Court on October 2, 2006, and obtained a copy of the minute order that he then submitted to the Court of Appeals on October 3, 2006. The Court of Appeals subsequently remanded the case back to Jefferson County District Court for lack of a written, signed, and dated order in compliance with C.R.C.P. Rule 58.
6. As of this date, Petitioner has not received a written, signed, and dated order in compliance with C.R.C.P. Rule 58.
