<p>FINAL STATUS REPORT AND COPY OF ORDER IN COMPLIANCE WITH C.R.C.P 58</p>	


Petitioner-Appellant, Bryan Spofford, representing himself in this matter provides the following status report and copy of the district court order entered on November 9, 2006.

1. The Court of Appeals determined in its order of March 30, 2006, that judicial economy would be served if the case were remanded to the district court and recertified after an order was entered on a second award of attorney fees. "After the matter has been resolved, appellant shall immediately forward a copy of the district court's order to this court, and the case shall be recertified. Appellant

may file a motion to amend the notice of appeal and to supplement the designation of record within 14 days after notice from this Court that the matter has been recertified.”

2. A 15-minute evidentiary hearing on the matter of attorney fees was held on September 29, 2006, and the district court ordered Petitioner-Appellant to pay \$1,929.82 directly to Gary Polidori, representing Respondent-Appellee. The total amount was comprised of \$879.82 for fees associated with Petitioner-Appellant’s 2005 motion for review of a magistrate order and \$1,050 for fees associated with the 15-minute evidentiary hearing.
3. Judge Tidball stated at the conclusion of the evidentiary hearing that a minute order would be added to the file and that neither party would receive a written or signed order in the mail. Petitioner-Appellant drove to Jefferson County District Court the following Monday, obtained a copy of the minute order, and mailed it to the Court of Appeals on October 3, 2006. This Court thereafter determined that Judge Tidball’s order was not in compliance with C.R.C.P. 58 and again remanded the case to district court.
4. An order in compliance with C.R.C.P. 58 was issued on November 9, 2006, and received by Petitioner-Appellant on November 13, 2006. A copy of the district court order in compliance with C.R.C.P. 58 is attached.

Wherefore, Petitioner-Appellant requests that the Court of Appeals recertify case No. 06CA0299.



ORDER	

This matter comes before the Court after an evidentiary hearing on Petitioner's Objection to Award of Attorney Fees and Request for Evidentiary Hearing. The Court considered the testimony from Gary Polidori, the arguments of the parties, the pleadings and court files, and the applicable law. The Court finds that the requested attorney fees are reasonable for the reasons set forth on the record. Petitioner is ordered to pay Respondent's attorney fees in the amount specified in the supplemental affidavit. Petitioner is ordered to pay an additional \$350 to Respondent for attorney fees incurred as a result of this hearing. The entire amount is to be paid by Petitioner to Gary Polidori within 15 days of the date of this hearing.


