Dear Roger:


I have received a fax from your client/my former client, Kim Thorup, regarding his El Paso County District Court matter and the issues surrounding Cindy Duckworth's involvement.

I am a little bit fuzzy on how it is that I ended up suggesting Maria Drost Services to our client, Kim Thorup. I believe that I called several counseling services in an effort to find somebody who could talk to Mr. Thorup right away in light of the fact that his parenting time with [REDACTED] had been terminated and I felt some urgency to get therapy going. I do recall that there was an Order requiring that he get therapy and it was my impression that his contacting any therapist was in furtherance of that Court Order. However, I have no recollection of asking for an evaluation, a report, or any direct contact by Cindy Duckworth with the El Paso County District Court. I am sure that I assumed she could become a witness for either side depending upon the evidentiary value of her impressions after counseling and therapy with Kim Thorup.

In the beginning, Cindy Duckworth was very helpful to Mr. Thorup in getting his parenting time reinstated. It is my recollection that their relationship began to sour and that I received calls from both Mr. Thorup and Cindy Duckworth, each expressing their displeasure with the other several months into the psychotherapeutic relationship.
