
**PETITIONER'S REPLY TO FATHER'S STATUS REPORT**

The Petitioner responds as follows to Father's Status Report:

1. "Father's" Motion for Review was filed December 4, 2007. The CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER (REVIEW OF MAGISTRATE DECISION) was issued by Division 4 of the District Court on January 8, 2008.
2. Father was given 30 days from January 8, 2008 to inform this Court of his progress in ordering a Transcript of the proceedings. Father's Status Report admits that he has not ordered a Transcript of the proceedings, as required by the Court.
3. Father's Status Report was filed late. The Status Report was filed on, or about February 8, 2008 and the 30 days given by the court to file the Status Report ended on February 7, 2008.
4. Father's Status Report gives excuses in the form of saying that his voice messages "Over the past month" have not been returned to him. There is no evidence of any further efforts on Father's part to order the Transcript such as, certifying that he went to the Court Clerk's Office to inquire into how to order a Transcript, or that he specifically requested the Clerk of Division 4 or Q to tell him how to order a Transcript of the proceedings, or that he had inquired with any other authorities at the El Paso County Courthouse as to how to order a Transcript of the proceedings in the last 60 days (since December 4, 2007).
5. Father has now let over 60 days go by without even beginning the process of ordering a Transcript of the proceedings as required by the Court and the rules.

6. Petitioner submits that the Court should proceed to decide this matter with no Transcript provided by Father. Father has not shown any grounds for a finding of excusable neglect in not ordering a Transcript by the deadline required by this Court.
